1. Linked Learning Discussion with Dean Fiene (attachment):

Dean Fiene explained that high schools across California have been implementing more and more Linked Learning opportunities which provides students with interdisciplinary coursework through a career focused theme. Currently there are 123 pathways in the region. The MOU President Morales signed with the Linked Learning Alliance promises CSUSB will explore linked learning opportunities. Dean Fiene would like to explore what Linked Learning means for CSUSB and what implications it may have as more high schools implement more pathways for students. Dean Fiene added that CSUSB could consider a pathway for students in a starter career to move through a baccalaureate program could be developed to aid more non-traditional college students among many other possibilities that could be explored by the campus. The EC decided that faculty should first be educated regarding Linked Learning and will have a presentation at an upcoming Senate meeting.
