


RESOLUTION OPPOSING TIMELINE FOR INPUT ON ACADEMIC PREPARATION

- WHEREAS:** CSU Coded Memorandum #ASA-2017-14 asks CSU campuses for input by June 16, 2017 on proposed changes to CSU policy “regarding competency in English and mathematics, developmental education, assessment and placement and the Early Start Program”; and
- WHEREAS:** The proposed changes in academic preparation will have significant effects on curriculum, for which faculty have primary responsibility; and
- WHEREAS:** The June 16th deadline largely precludes input from faculty, particularly at semester campuses; therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the CSUSB Faculty Senate express its opposition to any issuance of an executive order implementing the ideas contained in Coded Memorandum #ASA-2017-14 before meaningful consultation with faculty, which should not begin until faculty are under contract in Fall 2017, and must include a long enough timeline for serious consideration by several relevant Academic Senate and Campus bodies; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the CSUSB Faculty Senate send copies of this resolution to Chancellor White, Executive Vice Chancellor Blanchard, the Academic Senate of the CSU, and the Chairs of all CSU campus Senates.
