


**Resolution in Support of Academic Senate of the California State University Resolution [AS-3298-17/EX](#):
Violation of Confidentiality of CSU San Bernardino (CSUSB) Presidential Search Process and Censure of
Trustee Emeritus Lou Monville and Mr. Paul Granillo**

- Whereas:** The Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU) expressed grave concern about the violation of confidentiality of the CSUSB presidential search process by Trustee Emeritus, and former Chair of the CSU Board of Trustees, Lou Monville, and community member Paul Granillo in a May 8, 2017 op-ed about the CSUSB Academic Senate and its vote of no confidence in President Tomás Morales; and
- Whereas:** The Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU) unanimously passed Resolution [AS-3298-17/EX](#), Violation of Confidentiality of CSU San Bernardino (CSUSB) Presidential Search Process and Censure of Trustee Emeritus Lou Monville and Mr. Paul Granillo; therefore be it
- Whereas:** Trustee Emeritus Monville is scheduled to receive an Honorary Doctorate at the June 2017 CSUSB commencement ceremonies; and
- Whereas:** The California State University Board of Trustees' policy for awarding Honorary Degrees, adopted November 19, 2015, states, "Nominees must have demonstrated intellectual and humane values that are consistent with the ideals of California State University, the aims of higher education, and with the highest ideals of the person's chosen fields," as well as "nominees must demonstrate high moral character;" and
- Whereas:** The actions of Trustee Emeritus Monville that violated confidentiality of the CSUSB presidential search process are not consistent with the ideals of California State University; therefore, be it
- Resolved:** The Faculty Senate of California State University San Bernardino endorses the above mentioned ASCSU Resolution; and be it further
- Resolved:** That the Faculty Senate of California State University San Bernardino censures Mr. Granilo and Trustee Emeritus Monville and condemns their portrayal of academic senates and their violation of confidentiality; and be it further
- Resolved:** That the CSUSB Faculty Senate strongly opposes the BOT decision to award Trustee Emeritus Monville an honorary doctorate; and be it further
- Resolved:** That the CSUSB Faculty Senate send copies of this resolution to Chancellor White, the Board of Trustees, Trustee Emeritus Monville, CSUSB President Morales, CSUSB College of Arts and letters Dean Ballman, the Academic Senate of the CSU, and the Chairs of all the CSU campus senates.
